SUBJECT: IMMIGRATION PROCEDURES

POLICY: It shall be the policy of this Department not to arrest or detain any person for Illegal Entry unless specifically requested and actually assisted by agents of the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service.

REFERENCE: United States Code, Title 8.

PROCEDURE:

I. IMMIGRATION PROCEDURES

- A. Officers shall not stop, question, detain, arrest or place an "immigration hold" on any person not suspected of a crime, solely on the grounds that they may be a deportable alien.
- B. Officers shall not approach, question, detain, arrest, transport, and/or incarcerate any person for purposes of enforcing any provision(s) of Title 8 United States code, other than Alien Smuggling, except in the execution of a criminal arrest warrant authorizing arrest for an alleged violation of Title 8 United States Code.
